### Forest School

Please make sure your child has the appropriate clothing every week for Forest School.

This must not be part of their daily school uniform. Children are likely to get wet or muddy in Forest School and need something dry to get changed into after sessions.

Wellies that fit with child's name clearly marked

Long trousers (joggers are good)

Long sleeve t-shirt x 2

Long sleeve fleece or jumper

Extra tops

Extra socks x 2

Waterproof jacket with hood

Hat and gloves

Snow suits are great for the really cold winter days, usually later in the year, but not so great at the moment. Consider lots of layers as a better option, as they can be added or removed depending on the weather.
