

Animation

Download a stop frame animation app from the internet and try to create a movie. If you find a good one, post the details of Google Classroom for others to see.

Create a character out of lego, or Playdough or you can use a toy and make it do something.

Observations

Find a plant that is growing, it could be a tree with buds or a dandelion in the grass. Observe the plant each day and note down how it changes over the week. You could create drawings each day to show how it is changing. Give each a title and label the differences you can see.

Random story generator

Get some small pieces of paper and three pots. In one pot, write down names of characters (e.g. a wizard, an elephant and Mr Coe). In the next write down locations (the supermarket, on the moon, in the bath) and in the third write down problems (has no friends, hiding from the police, can't stop sneezing, can't stop lying). Get your family to help you, the more ideas you have the better. Then take one piece of paper from each pot and this is the basis for your story. You can describe the character, how they got into the problem and the resolution. The only limit is your imagination.

Butterflies

Last time you looked at birds, this time look out for butterflies. Make a note of colour and shape. See if you can identify it here, what are they doing, what plants are they on?
