

Can you design an eco friendly theme park? It needs to use renewable energy (solar, wind, hydro...). Does the log flume use recycled water? Is the rollercoaster powered by solar panels? Your theme park can be based on anything you like? It could be a jungle themed park, underwater park, space park. Anything you can think of. Remember to come up with a name for it!

Design a poster to advertise your theme park. It will need to be eye catching and contain persuasive language. You will need to also include things like ticket prices and opening hours.

Can you write a story based in a theme park? It could be a spooky story about getting stuck on the ghost train or a Disney inspired story where the rides transport you to the actual worlds they are from. It could even be about a theme park that just appears for one day of the year then vanishes at the stroke of midnight.

Disney Land has Mickey Mouse as a mascot. Who or what will be your mascot? You can have a more than one. Design your mascot and write a little description about them. Are they cheeky? Mischievous, friendly, spooky...?

Every good theme park needs a rollercoaster. Can you design a rollercoaster that will make people want to come to your park? Will it be the fastest in the world? Most amount of loops? Highest plummet? What's special about your rollercoaster? You can even build a model of it using Lego, junk modelling or anything else you can think of.

If people are spending the day at your theme park they are going to need places to eat. Can you make a menu for the food you will be serving your customers? Will the food match your theme? Eg. space burger and fries. Remember to write down the prices for each item of food and drink. What's the most expensive meal? What is the cheapest?

Using the internet and books, can you research the theme parks from around the world? What is the highest rollercoaster? Where is the biggest log flume? Where would you find the most amount of bumper?

Can you make your own games stool where people can win prizes? It could be based on one you've seen before like a hook a duck or coconut shy or it could be a completely original one. You will need to come up with the prizes people will win, the cost of a ticket to play and the instructions for how to play and win.
