This week in class....

Pre-School – Preschool have been making playdough this week. This has not only been useful to strengthen fine motors skills but has helped them to follow directions. We have also begun to introduce Little Wandle oral blending games to the children and lots of them have been able to do the actions we have asked i.e. 'touch your ar-m' or 'c-l-a-p your hands'. There are lots of these games we can play and all will help towards preparing the older children for learning phonics in Reception.

Acorn – Acorn class enjoyed the trip to Sheringham Park on Wednesday. The children had the opportunity to go pond dipping and animal tracking. We looked in detail at animal footprints and made casts of them. Then we went searching for animal's footprints in the mud. We were lucky enough to see two deer and watch them while they found safety in the forest. After lunch, we made homes for soft toy animals in the woods. It was a great day out embedding the learning we had done in the classroom on animals and their habitats.

Oak - Oak Class have been working hard on their addition and subtraction skills and are becoming more confident in using different resources which are of most use to them. This means that they are working more independently, which is great to see! We have also started to learn the 11 times table. On Thursday, we were able to present our story books to our pre-school audience. The children practised their reading aloud and presentation skills. We loved sharing our stories with the younger children and are really proud of our work! We have also completed our interpretations of The Scream which will be added to our art exhibition at the end of term.

Birch - Another industrious week in Birch in preparation for next week's big event, the Community Cafe. This week the children have been creating posters to advertise the event, menus and feedback forms for the event and even online shopping to gain prices for their shopping list. They have worked within their budget, using spreadsheets to calculate amounts and costs from the recipes. Today we baked our first, trial batch of brownies and devoured them after forest school, they were outstanding!

In maths we have been looking at equivalent fractions and calculating fractions, applying what we have learnt in our multiplication to different areas of maths. We have also finished writing up our scary stories. We used all the previous work we had done, building setting, describing characters and using tension building devices, placing them altogether to create our complete, scary story. These have been written up and will be on display shortly.

Please pop along, if you are not working, and sample our cakes and drinks. The children have worked hard to ensure this is a great community event and have created feedback forms to make the next event even better.







Forest School News - Last week Oak class made brilliant masks! Everyone gave it a really good go, some found the stitching tricky but showed great perseverance.
