Oak - Oak Class have turned creative this week. In maths they have created their own festive themed maths problems for each other, written them out as problems and then swapped for their peers to solve. They have then written and received feedback on what went well and how to improve these in the future. The children have also been crafting Christmas decorations and cards this week. The classroom has been a hive of activity and has been glittered relentlessly, poor old Richard the caretaker. Birch - This week has been festive themed in Birch class. We have conducted Christmas Science beginning with chromatography to create filter paper Christmas trees, then we looked at molecular bonds, changing the bonds in PVA glue and altering its properties. Finally, we have looked at osmosis and how food colouring disperses in Gelatine. The children have also used Kahoot this week, designing sticky knowledge quizzes based on our topic work, ask your children how many bridges are in the Parish of Northrepps! On Wednesday the children were superbly behaved at the panto and were a credit to the school. The gentleman organising the seating etc was very complimentary of them and even commented how they were looking after the younger students.
