This week in class...

Little Brown Hare - This week we have been learning all about birds. We have used our explorer bags with binoculars and ID sheets, noticing the birds that visit our feeders at LBH. We have been investigating feathers and been creative and imaginative with paint. The children joined in with making little bird finger puppets and learnt a new rhyme 'Two little dickie birds'. Blackbirds - Blackbirds Class have been very excited this week to receive a present of some new magnetic construction equipment. This has been bought with money kindly given by the Friends - thank you! Everyone has been busy building all week and, when the buildings are complete, the children have been writing about the photos, which is a really good way to inspire everyone to have a go at writing. As well as all our building, the children have been learning the story of the Three Little Pigs this week. We have been learning the story with actions, learning about pigs and wolves and drawing pictures of them, acting out the story and thinking about what the different characters might say.







This week in class...

Wagtails - This week in Wagtails we have received a letter to join a Viking Jarl in his exciting trip to Britain. To be accepted into his traveling party, we needed to prove we had a good knowledge of the Viking way of life. We looked at where the Vikings came from and why they were looking for new places to live. We found out that Viking kings ruled over smaller kingdoms and that Jarls were powerful chiefs that owned large areas of land, ships, men and horses. We also looked at the different routes the Vikings took from Scandinavia.

Skylarks - As mathematicians, Skylarks are really working hard on their special number facts such as multiples of 9, prime factors and composite numbers. Our study of mechanisms continues with a close look at levers, pulleys and cogs used in punishment contraptions! This has also helped us consider and design a time machine to take us to Viking, Roman, Tudor, Georgian and Victorian time periods..
