## This week in class...

**Preschool** - Preschool have been learning about the importance of looking after your teeth this week. We have discussed foods that are good for you and those that are less so. We have chatted about going to the dentist and watched a video about how to clean our teeth. We also practiced how to use a toothbrush too. Other activities have included lots of junk-modelling, building pirate ships and recognising numerals.

**Acorn** - The children in Acorn really enjoyed Number Day last Friday. They had the chance to work with children from Birch on a variety of maths investigations and play some games. On Tuesday the children explored the woods at Forest School. We had a fire as it was so cold and the children had a chance to revisit the rules about being near fires. In the middle of the session we stopped exploring to have hot chocolate by the fire, which was lovely in the icy weather. In literacy we have done some work around our explorer story 'Max's Jungle Adventure' and are beginning to learn the story through actions and a storymap.

**Oak** - Oak Class loved their gymnastics session this week and had a fantastic time practicing balancing skills, using the beams and bars, as well as great fun in the foam pit. They were challenged to work in teams and to learn new skills, like forwards and backwards rolls, handstands and cartwheels. We have completed our neat copies of our longhouse adverts and these are now on display in the classroom. In music, we have explored rhythm and used the glockenspiels to find the beat to a song. Oak Class have really enjoyed their maths topic on data collection and have learned how to plan a research question, collect data and draw bar charts to show their results. **Birch** - This week in Birch Class we started to find out about Anne Frank and her diary. This led us to think about what it must have been like as a child in different parts of the world during World War II and we began writing our own diary entries for a child in Great Britain in the 1940s. The children wrote some extremely thoughtful and impressive entries - Well done Birch Class!



**Forest School News** - Oak class had a great day in the woods. They loved the new mud kitchen and played and played mixing, stirring and collecting. We played the worm game and put the kids into bird teams to hunt for their coloured worms. They showed great team work and perseverance as the brown worms where a challenge to find!
