Emotions Characters: Draw a 6 box grid in your Journal. Design 6 different characters to represent 6 different emotions. Their design and colour is up to you! Please write some labels around your characters so we know more about them.

Nature Portrait: can you collect things from your garden or on a walk and create a picture with the materials? You could collect leaves, sticks and fallen flowers (remember not to pick anything). This could be a picture of a person, an animal, an emotion or your own design! Create your design on the ground or beach and take a picture to stick in your Journal.
