Find out about Sutton Hoo. Create a fact file including text, pictures and a map. Remember to use headings or bullet points to help you organise your work.

Research a Viking god. Draw or paint a picture of your chosen god. Annotate your picture or include some facts about them on another page.

Interview some family members to find out their views. What is their favourite history topic? Why? Do they remember any facts about it? Do they think it is important to learn about history and why?

Remember to try and choose one activity to do each week. You can present your work in lots of different ways and can write in the book or stick in your work. Please make sure it is always neat and tidy and only use pencil to write in your homework book. We will share any homework completed in class.

Create your own Viking character. You could draw a picture and label it. Give your character a name. Write some facts about your character or write a short story with them in it!
