Choose one of the countries the Vikings came from (Norway, Denmark and Sweden) and research what it is like now. How many people live there? What are the traditions they have? Are any still around from Viking times?

Look at some pictures of Anglo-Saxon patterns. Can you create your own? Can you add colour using paints, crayons, collage etc.

Can you draw a picture of a battle between the Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons? What equipment will both sides have?

Find out about 5 key dates in Viking times and place them on a timeline. This can be a small timeline in your book or maybe even a time line that stretches across the floor!
