Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back after what I hope was a fun and restful Christmas break. Here are a few reminders about things you need to know in Blackbirds Class:

PE

PE is on Friday afternoons with Mrs Rowe. Please remember to come to school in PE kit on a Friday. Remember, that the children will be in their kit all day, so please make sure they are warm enough in these winter months.

Outdoor Clothes

All of the children need waterproof clothing (trousers and a jacket, or a set of overalls) and wellies in school. They will need these for Forest School on a Tuesday, but also for science lessons, playtimes and other outdoor activities. **Please make sure these stay in school**, or, if they come home, that they are back in school the next day.

Forest School

Sessions for Blackbirds are on Tuesday afternoons. The children will need to come into school in old clothes on a Tuesday, that are suitable for Forest School (legs and arms covered). They do not need to come into school in their waterproofs and boots, as these should be in school already.

Tapestry

Don't forget to log into tapestry regularly, to see updates of your children's work, messages about events, weekly recaps and information about what we will be learning. If you cannot get onto tapestry, please see Mrs Barry for more information. Thank you to those of you who have been posting pictures of things the children have done at home. They love sharing these with their friends.

Phonics and Books

The children need to bring their book bag into school each day, as they are reading several times a week. When they have read a book in school three times, they will bring it home to read at home and will have that book for a week. They can also have a reading for pleasure library book to take home. Please do not put water bottles into book bags, as they often leak on our reading books.



Other useful things

It is really important that the children keep hydrated. Please could they have a water bottle each day to use in school.
