Please share this knowledge organiser with your child to help them develop their knowledge and understanding of our topic. This knowledge organiser describes what is expected of the year one children. Reception children will access the curriculum at whatever level is appropriate for them.

What I will learn:

- What are primary colours and how to use them to mix other colours (reception)
- The difference between 2D and 3D art
- That there are four seasons in the year spring, summer, autumn and winter
- That we have five senses seeing, hearing, smelling, touching and tasting.
- How to sew simple stitches; how to use a hammer, saw and use sandpaper; how to follow a simple recipe and use scales.

Key Vocabulary

- Primary colours
- Secondary colours
- Colour names including different shades of colours eg: turquoise, crimson, scarlet, navy blue.
- Festival names: Christmas, Harvest, Diwali, Eid-ul-Fitr, Advent.
- Names of parts of the body eg: elbow, neck, ankle, wrist, hip, thigh etc

Key Outcomes - Christmas nativity play in church; a school Christmas celebration.
